

Time limit of Public Speaking at Council Meetings

Study with various cities

City of Lake Oswego	On agenda	<i>3 minutes: The purpose of citizen comment is to allow citizens to present information or raise an issue regarding items not on the agenda or regarding agenda items that do not include a public hearing. A time limit of three minutes per citizen shall apply.</i>
City of Beaverton		5 minutes allowed unless a group, then they have to choose one representative and allowed up to 10 minutes.
City of Newberg	On agenda	3 minutes minimum and 5 minutes maximum
City of Philomath	*	5 minutes with a written request submitted to City Recorder prior to start of meeting.
City of Mt. Angel	On agenda	Written copies submitted to council and 3 minute limit
City of Carlton		3 minutes
City of Central Point	Any item	5 minutes - Groups on land use may have 10 minutes (Mayor will open any issue to the public if he knows they are interested).
City of Coburg		5 minutes - Must see Mayor prior to meeting to speak and sign in
City of Ashland		3 – 5 minutes depending on amount of people. Must fill out request form.
City of Bend		3 minutes – use of stop watch and chime
City of Eugene	*	3 minutes
City of Estacada	*	3 minutes and can not readdress and no more testimony after motion has been made
City of Gresham	*	3 minutes
City of Bandon		3 – 5 minutes
City of Springfield	*	3 minutes
